Skill development programs for students like implant workshops, basic life support training etc have been planned


Improving teaching learning methodologies, there by making the entire process of learning student centered by faculty training on teaching methodology through programs like RAATI and TOT.

GOAL 4: DIGITIZATION


Training of faculty and students to utilize various LMS software, JUNO app, G-health for various academic and administrative activities.

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GOAL 6: CAREER GUIDANCE AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES

In order to ensure holistic student development the institution through its curriculum development committee plan and organize various skill development and career placement initiatives. To enhance skill quotient of students, the student will be subjected to undergo various activities and learning sessions planned by preclinical department to learn various skill initiatives through simulation mode before the hands-on clinical exposure.

To conduct 3-5 Programs on various other career options, opportunities abroad and in the research field for interns and postgraduate students

Preparatory courses are conducted from 4th BDS itself to orient students and prepare them for NEET MDS admission. Each department HOD will interact with concerned students regularly and address them in subject details pertaining to NEET exam.

All the departments in the dental college allot a particular syllabus to the students on Monday afternoon and the students are asked to prepare accordingly. Every Thursday students participate in group discussion to discuss the allotted topic. On Saturday's a MCQ test is conducted which is evaluated and the students are assessed on a weekly basis. One month prior to the NEET PG examination. Mock exams are conducted for all the subjects. Resource persons are invited to orient, energize and motivate students for the NEET pg exam. Our alumni are also invited to share their experience regularly with the students.

GOAL 7: STUDENT SUPPORT AND GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL

Institution houses well structured student support mechanism through various functional student bodies in the institution such as student council, curriculum development committee, IQAC etc through the committees the students shall be put in forward the requisite required by them to improve teaching /learning methodology as well as campus life the same will be addressed by institution.

The institution has further constituted structured grievance redressal mechanism to handle any untoward incidence that arises.


