



As per the instructions from the Institutional Curriculum committee, the department conducted the departmental curriculum meeting on 04 September 2020, in the post graduate section of the Department at 10.30 am. The committee composed of the Head of the Department and all the staff members of the department. The below mentioned agendas were discussed and the resolutions were formed. These ideas and changes were recommended to be incorporated in the department's day to day functioning.

Agenda:

- New approved syllabus for BDS students to be circulated among all faculty members forwarded by the principal.
- To prepare teaching schedules for BDS students based on new approved syllabus.
- To list out the new practical quota for both the under graduate and post graduate students and implement for the new 2020 batch students.
- To add Clinical histopathological studies for the post graduate students.
- To schedule and list out 7 inter-disciplinary courses for post graduate students.
- To schedule and implement 7 Add-On courses for post graduate students. This year, "Loupes in Dentistry" to be introduced as a new topic for the students.
- To schedule and list out Value added courses. This year, "Nutrition" to be added as a topic for value added course.
- To schedule field visits, internship programmes, research projects, community postings for under-graduate and post graduate students.



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- Two field visits for post graduate students to Oxford Medical College and Kanva Diagnostics to be planned.
- To encourage faculties to participate in BoS / Academic council and question paper designing - evaluation and assessment.
- To discuss about inviting alumina students as speakers for add on courses and value added courses.
- It will be discussed to introduce online classes for all under graduate and post graduate students by the faculty of department. This may be carried out through various online platforms like Zoom or Microsoft Teams or Webex.
- It needs to be suggested that al faculty attend a training programme to conduct online classes using the Zoom or Microsoft teams online platforms.
- The same theory and practical timetable will be followed for the online classes for both under graduates and post graduates.
- It will be suggested to mark the attendance for all theory classes and practical classes taken online in the attendance registers on the same day, by the respective staff.
- It will be suggested to conduct discussions, seminars, VIVA and demonstrations during online practical classes demonstration to train the under graduate students.
- To set time of commencement of the PG seminars or JC discussion and change the place to conduct the same, in order to maintain social distancing and follow proper COVID protocol.
- Post graduate students to be instructed to schedule the seminars or journal clubs a week before. The respective students to create the Webex link for the same and send the invite the previous day of the presentations. The soft copy of the presentations to be sent to their respected guides and present only after approval.
- Post graduate students to be instructed to send the soft copy of their dissertations, for corrections, to their respective guides.



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- To discussion on the Guidelines for Doctors, Dental supporting staff and students, given by DCI for treatment protocol. This needs to be considered as all patients to be considered as potential source of infection.
- To plan out and design the Aerosol and Non Aerosol sections in the department and list out the disinfection protocol for the department. The comprehensive treatment
- To set appropriate infection control guidelines with special consideration to aerosol generating procedures.
- To discussion on comprehensive training for all department faculty and students regarding the Standard Operating procedures related to disinfection protocol of the department.
- To train all department faculty and students in pre-screening and Triaging of patients, recording case history and identification of vulnerable age groups. This will include screening for symptoms of COVID to avoid/ minimise the exposure of faculty, students and to patients.
- To discuss the ways to regulate the entry of patients and ensure use of mouth masks/ face shield, hand hygiene and maintaining optimum physical distance as per the standard guide lines set by the ICMR.
- To train department faculty and students regarding personal protection during treatment procedures.
- To prepare a rooster to post staff on rotation, to monitor the aerosol and non aerosol sections of the department and check the clinical workflow of the under graduate and post graduate students.
- To instruct all faculty, students and patients to submit RTPCR negative report, to follow safe physical distancing, disinfection & sterilization protocol on time to time basis.
- To discussion on methods of conducting practical examination for both undergraduate and post graduate students under COVID Scenario.
- To make a rooster to post 2nd year post graduate students, on rotation, to Jayadeva Cardiology Hospital and Oxford Medical college.
- Staff and post graduate students to be informed to apply for research grants.



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- Post graduate students to be instructed to attend online PG conventions and conferences and complete their quota of poster presentations and paper presentations.
- The Post graduate students to complete all the seminars, journal club presentations, clinical work and special cases as per the university curriculum. This needs to be checked and verified by the respective guides.
- The post graduate students to maintain and update log book as per the curriculum.

As per the instructions from the Institutional Curriculum Committee, the department conducted meeting on 04 September, 2020. The Department of Prosthodontics meeting was held in the seminar room, from 10:00 AM onwards. The committee was composed of Head of Department and all the staff members of the department. The below mentioned agendas discussed and resolutions were formed. These were recommended to be inculcated in department and implementation of same.

Agendas:

- HOD with the help of Zoom application conducted meeting of staff regarding academic curriculum during the COVID19 pandemic.
- All patients visiting the department must be considered as potential source of infection and dental professionals must follow appropriate infection prevention control guidelines
- All patients entering OPD should be screened for symptoms of COVID to avoid / minimize exposure to staff and to patients. Regulate entry of patients and ensure use of mask/face cover, hand hygiene and physical distancing, as per the standard protocols advocated by M/o Health & Family Welfare.
- The faculty were advised to engage in online teaching to the students and complete the curriculum through remote teaching as per further instructions furnished by higher authorities.
- The faculty may document the details of class taken, students engaged, percentage of attendance, assignments given and their assessments.



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- All routine academic activities like seminars, journal club and other discussions may be carried out using various learning resources, technology platform and innovative teaching approaches.
- It was proposed that all post graduates seminars/journal club will be scheduled a week before. The respective students will create the zoom link for the same and presentations would be done on Zoom platform.
- It was also proposed by HOD, to take the theory classes online with the help of Zoom platform, and attendance to be marked for same in the attendance registers on the very same day by respective staff members. The practical classes were also conducted online in the form of discussions and demonstrations by the concerned unit.
- Infection control guidelines with special considerations for aerosol or splatter generating procedures should be followed. As per the instructions, under COVID19 scenario, the functioning of department for non aerosol procedures would be carried out in the department and all aerosols procedures would be carried out in the aerosol section following all COVID protocols.
- The staff members will be posted to aerosol and non aerosol departments on rotation to assess the clinical workflow of the undergraduates and postgraduates.
- It was also discussed that all (CAP) COVID Appropriate Protocol, will be followed both the undergraduates and postgraduates' students in rehabilitating edentulism.
- Instructions were given to all the teaching staff, non teaching staff, students and patients to submit RTPCR negative report, to follow physical distancing, disinfection & sterilization protocol on time-to-time basis.
- Standard Operating Procedures will be followed strictly in the pre-clinical, clinical and laboratory sections as per the COVID Appropriate Protocol. It was proposed by HOD to divide the entire workflow into the units and deploying the same at the preclinical, clinical and post graduate level.



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- The staff in charge were informed to update OPD register, treatment register, consumables and non-consumables register, implant case register, Danthabhagya register.
- Based on the discussions, senior lecturers were allocated at the preclinical section, and offshore works at Jayadeva institute of cardiology.
- It was proposed that the PG's seminars/ journal clubs will be scheduled online at 9:15 AM sharp on all day. Staff members were also instructed not to attend the seminars late.
- Leaves of all kinds especially earned leaves will be sanctioned for 50% of staff depending on their cadre. If staff members avail in spite of this, the leave may not be sanctioned.
- HOD proposed the staff name for the non-academic extension activities like

 - h. Theory class attainment in charge – Dr. Ravi Kumar
- It was informed by HOD, to implement prescribed latest regulations and syllabus by the RGUHS, that has to be followed.
- It was proposed that, teaching and training of the 1st BDS and 2nd BDS Students will consist of one unit comprising of 1 professor, 2 readers and 3 senior lecturers.
- Open book method of reading for 2nd year BDS was proposed.



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- Itinerary for the Celebration of Worlds elders' day and Prosthodontist Day were discussed and finished.
- It was also informed that, timetable of theory and practical posting for regular and odd batch has to be followed for undergraduates (UG) as well as postgraduates (PG).
- It was discussed to keep a tab on underperformers and take necessary actions prior to the university examination.
- Teaching and clinical training of III yere and IV-year BDS students consists of one professor, two readers and three senior lecturers.
- The training of undergraduates includes discussions, seminars, demonstration and completing of patient work as per university curriculum.
- The staff were instructed to update marks, attendance in the pupil- pod software as well as in the office.
- The postgraduate's curriculum was followed as per timetable uninstructed to maintain and update the logbook as per the curriculum.
- I MDS curriculum consists of submission of synopsis, preclinical exercises and library dissertation.
- II MDS curriculum, under guidance of allotted guides will complete the seminar journal clubs and all specialty cases.
- III MDS students will submit their dissertation and trained in teaching skills and satisfy the academic curriculum.
- One staff was made in charge of interns to monitor and maintain the attendance register, outpatient duty, active participation in the camp, submission of charts and treating distal extension cases.
- Maximum efforts to make faculties to participate in board of studies/ academic council in affiliated university.



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- It is decided to implement 3 Add-on courses for this academic year for post-graduates' students of all year. - It is advised by HOD to continue 7 interdisciplinary courses for post graduates of our as well as other departments. The IDM were as follows

 2. Principles of smile designing and treatment planning.
 3. Vertical dimension – what, how and when to manipulate
 4. Facebow transfer for FMR
 5. Bone mapping and three-dimensional fabrication of dental implants surgical stents.
 6. Diagnosis & treatment planning for pre-prosthetic surgery.
 7. Resection and rehabilitation – MFP.
- It is decided to implement 2 value added program this year, "PATIENT RELATIONSHIP MANAGEMENT" and "ERGONOMICS IN DENTISTRY" FOR UNDERGRADUATES AND POSTGRADUATES.


