The various oral hygiene measures one can take to maintain the oral health includes:

Use of toothbrush and toothpaste, Brush twice a day at morning before food and night after food, use of dental floss, Use of tongue cleaner to keep the tongue clean, Use of mouth rinses as recommend by the dentist and visit the dentist regularly.

Oral Health Awareness programmes are usually conducted in institutions to instil upon the children the importance of oral hygiene and to teach them the correct methods of brushing and to enable them to develop the habit of brushing their teeth twice a day and to use other oral hygiene aids like tongue cleaners etc.

Our team consisted of a faculty member and four dentists pursuing post-graduation in the Department of Public Health Dentistry, The Oxford Dental College, Bangalore. Inauguration was carried out by Dr. Smitha V Reddy (Medical officer – PHC Begur) at Booth no.1 at PHC Begur at 8:00 AM. It was mandatory to maintain physical distance, to wear masks and wash hands during the activity. Persons/children with fever/cough or other symptoms of COVID-19 were not allowed inside the booth. Crowding was avoided at booths and only one caregiver was allowed to accompany each beneficiary. Children immunized recently under the routine schedule and the new-borns were given 2 drops of oral polio vaccine. To identify the missed-out children, marking was done for all vaccinated children on the left little finger.

Around 648 children in the age group of 0-5 years were administered polio drops. Thanks to the successful implementation of the pulse polio immunization campaigns, the State entered the 17th polio-free year. It is essential to sustain the status and protect children from wild polio virus.

Vaccination adopted: COVISHIELD Vaccine.

Description: With a population of 1.38 billion, in the initial phase of the COVID-19 vaccination programme, India aims at vaccinating 300 million people by August 2021, including 30 million health workers and frontline workers (eg: police, soldiers), and 270 million elderly people (ie, aged over 50 years) and people with co-morbidities. India has been initiated with two types of vaccines: Covishield (Serum Institute of India Ltd) and Covaxin (by Bharat Biotech International Ltd). In view to this, the vaccination campaign was conducted in The Oxford Dental college in collaboration with BBMP. The college was provided with the COVISHIELD vaccine. The vaccination programme was conducted on the ground floor of Oxford Dental College. Doctors, nurses, and the concerned officials from BBMP came to the college. A total of 485 people was vaccinated that included All the faculty, students & non-teaching staff as per the list of the eligible medical professionals, medical students, attenders etc which was made priorly by BBMP & College for vaccination. The eligible people were vaccinated using the COVISHIELD vaccine. People were made aware of the mild side effects which may occur after administration of the vaccine, which need not be worried about. People who were vaccinated were given instructions regarding the scheduled second dose of the vaccination.


