Programmes are conducted regarding community skills, infection control ,biomedical waste management and the professional ethics to be followed at the institutional level In this programme the speakers emphasise on the sterilisation protocol before working on patients and how the disposal of the hospital waste is followed The students are also guided regarding the professional ethics., were in they are thought about the communication skills with patients .

The college organises orientation programme for all the interns which is mandatory for the interns to attend. In this event Principal, all the department heads, staff and a guest speaker attend the programme The speaker briefs the interns about the 1year compulsory rotatory internship ,protocols for working in the institution, public health centres, ,professional ethics to be followed etc . The Principal tells them about code of conduct, dress code, discipline to be followed in the campus etc. The head of the department from each department explains the interns about how their department functions with a set protocol how the patient treatment is done, regarding the appointments type of cases handled in the department They are also told about timings to report for duty every day and the work load in the department.

All these programmes are organised every year in the institution by different committees in the college with a maximum participants of 100 in 1st year BDS ,about 60-70 participants in 3rd BDS and almost 100 and above participants in interns The events are well organised by the committees in the college auditorium which starts of with an invocation and lamp lighting ,ends up after the speeches by the speakers with a national anthem .Finally all the events end up with lunch or high tea. The students and the interns go back to the respective departments where posted and follow the instructions with working protocol.

Report on infection control and biomedical waste management

The Oxford Dental college and hospital follows the protocol of the infection control and biomedical waste management. The programme for nurses and technicians was organised on 11/08/20, in the seminar room of the department of public health dentistry at 11:30 am they were educated on sterilization of the instruments using autoclave they were briefed about chair side disinfection and fumigation of clinical sections at the end of the day

The programme for technicians was organised on 11/12/20 and all the technicians were educated about the disinfection of the impressions of the patients, the models of the impressions and equipment in the lab area and they were also guided to follow the infection control protocol in the laboratory area.

The programme for housekeeping staff was organised on 15/02/2021, were they were educated about the most important requirement in the hospital is to maintain the hygiene which is done by the house keeping staff that there is no harm from the hospital side to the sick people and to avoid any cross infections from other patients and doctors. All the clinical sections and the departments in the college follow the segregation of waste by placing separate bins for contaminated waste by the house keeping staff, plastics etc which is maintained by the house keeping staff, chair side protocols are followed by all the undergraduate, postgraduate students and staff during the treatment procedures till the patients are discharged from the clinics, the segregated biomedical waste is disposed from the hospital and authorised agencies.
