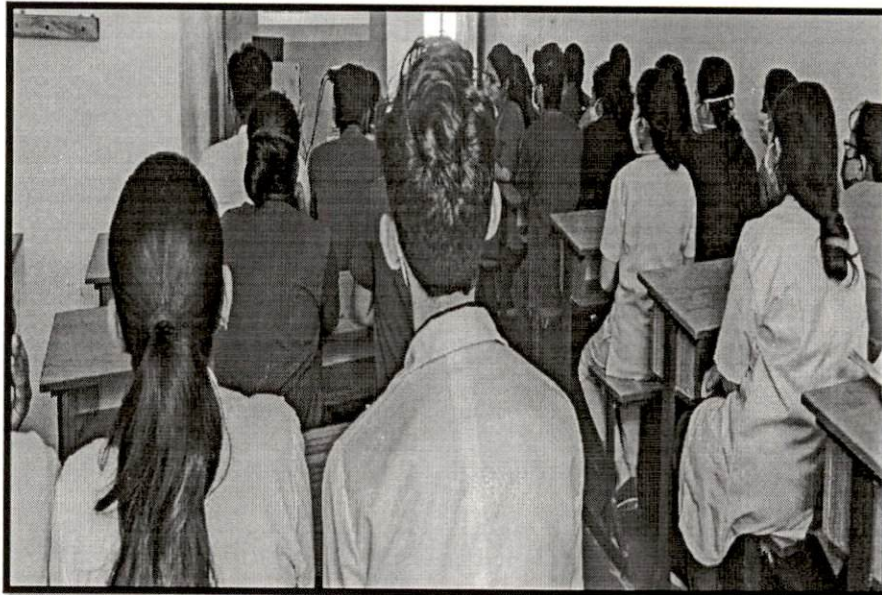
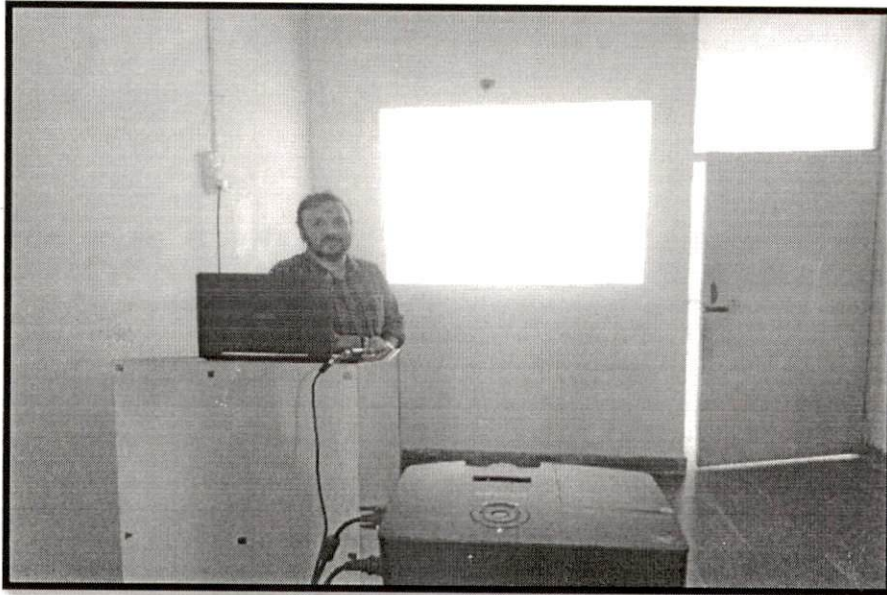

Digitalized dentistry enables efficient, fast and precise and error free production of fixed prosthodontics appliances. Early 1980s also paved a way for computer aided design/computer aided manufacturing (CAD-CAM) technology. She also covered clinical and lab procedures like use of CAD-CAM technology, stereo lithography, rapid prototyping, use of virtual articulators and digital face bows, digital radiographs and also in the field of training education and research by the use of virtual patient program, dental software, electronic recording of jaw motion, retention testing device, audio visual aids.

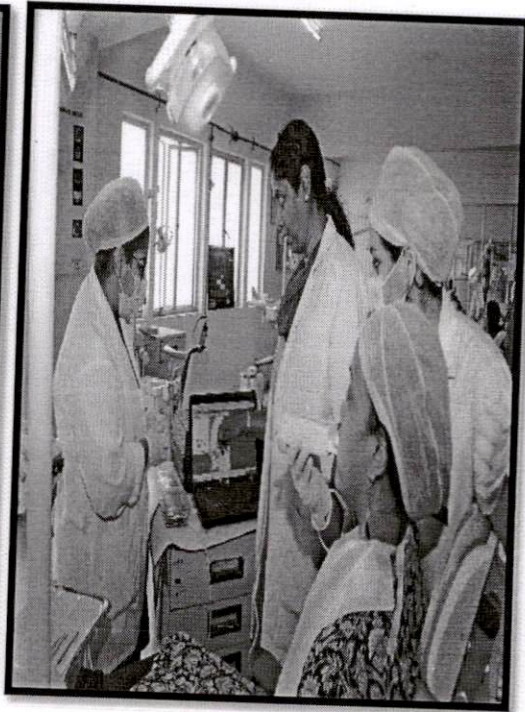
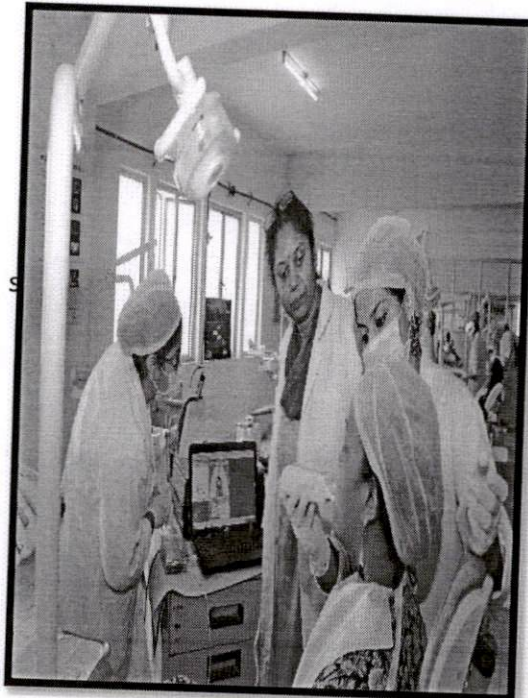

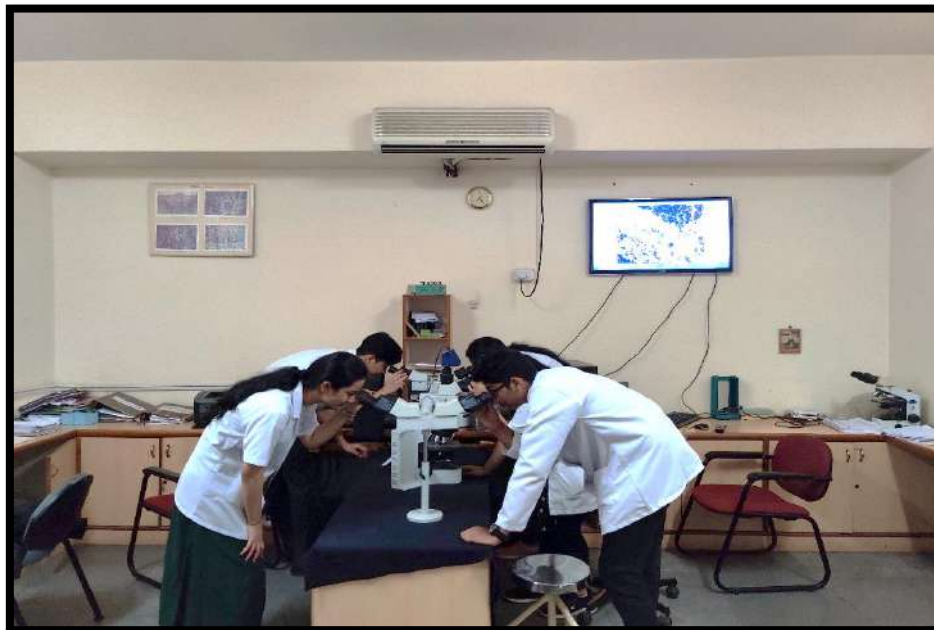

**Description:** Dr. S.V.M Thirumurugan, 3D Healthcare Consultant, explains in detail about the concept of 3D-printing with their potential applications in medical and dental fields. He took sessions and lectures on how to replace or repair a damaged tooth using CAD designs, create an orthodontic model, crown, prosthesis, dentures, surgical tools etc. The main benefit which he explained was related to maxillofacial prosthesis, to produce exact shape, size and colour of MFP for trauma and cancer cases. Also, the main help with this technique was that dental and orthopaedic services are faster and more accurate. This course reviews the types of 3D printing technologies available and their various applications in dentistry in MFP surgery.
