Library physical layout includes reading room, reference section, stack room, periodical section, circulation counter etc.

- 1. Library Rules and Regulations: Library rules and regulation should be explained before the library users in Library Orientation Programme. Instructions for the new members about the use of library must include in Library orientation Programme.
- 2. Library Collection: Users must provide adequate information on library collection. Various types of library collection e.g. printed books, printed journal, digital books, online books and journals, manuscripts, audio visual resources are available in the library, would be include in the orientation programme.
