Notice

Rules & Regulation for the Pedestrian Friendly Road in the College Campus

- 1. All traffic/parking rules and regulations are in effect 24/7.
- 2. The speed limit on the college streets is strictly 30 kilometres per hour (30kph).
- 3. The speed limit within the college parking zones is strictly 10 kilometres per hour (10kph).
- 4. Driver's License upon entering the college premises. Security guards have the authority to confirm identity of the people entering the college premises.
- 5. Pedestrian have the right-of-way at ALL TIMES on designated areas. Always give way to passing pedestrians. Stop at least 1 meter before a pedestrian lane.
- 6. Motor vehicles (including motorcycles) and bicycles may only be driven on roadways as sidewalks and path walks are for pedestrians.
- 7. Cross the streets using the pedestrian lanes. Jaywalking is strictly prohibited. Pedestrian lanes also known as zebra lines are intended for pedestrians. As pedestrian, you must look to your left and then to your right before crossing the street
- 8. Use of cell phones while driving is strictly prohibited
- 9. Driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs is strictly prohibited. If you drink don't drive; if you drive don't drink
- 10. Headlights must be turned on from dusk until dawn while driving in the college campus.
- 11. Drivers must follow all traffic and street signs inside the campus. Alteration, removal and defacing any of the signage are prohibited.
- 12. Driving, road and pedestrian courtesy must be observed at all times. Threatening or verbal abuse of students, fellow drivers, parents, traffic enforcers/guards, or any member of the college community is considered a violation.
- 13. Loading and unloading is allowed at designated areas only.
