The programme for technicians was organised on 08/12/16 and all the technicians were educated about the disinfection of the impressions of the patients, the models of the impressions and equipment in the lab area and they were also guided to follow the infection control protocol in the laboratory area.

The programme for housekeeping staff was organised on 13/04/2017 they were educated about the most important requirement in the hospital is to maintain the hygiene which is done by the house keeping staff that there is no harm from the hospital side to the sick people and to avoid any cross infections from other patients and doctors.
